

BOOKMARKS AND BOX BRAIDS

CREATE A MIXED MEDIA BOKMARK INSPIRED BY THE ARTWORK OF CHICAGO-BASED ARTIST TYLER CLARK. LEARN AND CELEBRATE BLACK CULTURE FROM ITS ROOTS THROUGH THE PRESENT!

SUPPLIES INCLUDED: BOOKMARK BASE BOOK PAPER SLIP PAPER PERSON & PAPER ARMS COLOR PAPER (3 PIECES) HAIR ACCESSORIES- RUBBER BANDS & BEADS

> WHAT YOU'LL NEED: SCISSORS LIQUID GLUE FINE TIPPED BLACK MARKER

ASSEMBLY

<u>Step 1:</u>

GLUE THE SLIP OF BOOK PAPER TO THE BOOKMARK BASE.

STEP2:

GLUE YOUR PERSON TO THE BOOKMARK.

<u>STEP 3:</u>

CUT THE COLORED PAPER TO CREATE CLOTHES AND ACCESSORIES. THEN GLUE THEM TO YOUR DOLL.

<u>STEP 4:</u>

GLUE DOWN THE ARMS AND ADD ANY FINAL TOUCHES! I GAVE MY DOLL EDGES WITH A BLACK MARKER.





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LIKE THE REAL THING, THERE ARE MULTIPLE WAYS TO STYLE YOUR PAPER PERSON'S HAIR. YOU CAN DO SOMETHING AS SIMPLE AS A HAIRCUT OR YOU CAN PLAY AROUND WITH TEXTURE AND TRY OUT SOME OF THE TECHNIQUES BELOW.

"TWIST OUT"

BRAIDS







"BANTU KNOTS"

BANTU KNOTS ARE SECTIONS OF BRAIDED OR TWISTED HAIR WRAPPED AROUND ITSELF AND SECURED IN A SMALL KNOTTED BUN.

CREATE THESE FAUX BANTU KNOTS BY WINDING BRAIDED OR TWISTED HAIR INTO A SPIRAL AND SECURING IT TO THE BOOKMARK WITH GLUE.



BEADS

OFTEN TIMES BRAIDED HAIRSTYLES WILL BE DECORATED WITH ACCESSORIES LIKE BEADS.

THREAD A SECTION OF HAIR THROUGH YOUR BEAD OR BEADS. THEN FOLD THE END OF THE HAIR **BACK TOWARD THE STRAND** ND SECURE IT RUBBERBA WITH A NN THE FINAL BEAD A BETWEEN ND THE REST. SLIDE THE REMAINI NG **BEDS OVER THE RUBBERBAND** TO HIDE IT.







TWO-STRAND TWISTS

TAKE TWO EVEN SECTIONS OF HAIR AND TWIST THEM AROUND EACH OTHER. YOU MAY NEED TO SECURE YOUR TWIST WITH A RUBBERBAND SO IT DOESN'T UNRAVEL.



UP DOS

GO BACK TO BASICS WITH A CLASSIC PONYTAIL OR BUN!

FOR THE BUN SHOWN HERE, GATHER ALL OF THE HAIR AND TWIST IT UNTIL IT BEGINS TO FORM A SPIRAL. THEN SECURE YOUR BUN WITH A RUBBERBAND!
