Seed Library

The Seed Library opens March 1 and will remain available while supplies last

Visit the Dundee Library and kick-start your garden with free seeds from our Seed Library! Explore hundreds of varieties, including flowers, herbs, vegetables, fruits, and native plants.

The FRVPLD Seed Library provides patrons free heirloom and openpollinated seeds to grow at home. You're also welcome to contribute harvested seeds to help replenish our inventory and keep the collection thriving.

Located on the main level of the Dundee Library, the Seed Library offers packets of seeds to grow approximately three plants. Each packet is labeled and includes growing instructions to help your garden flourish.

Gardening Tool Kits are available for checkout from our Library of Things! Each kit includes essential tools such as a seed planting trowel, weed puller, bypass pruning shears, hand shovel, hand rake, and hand spade. Kits can be borrowed for three weeks to help you tackle your gardening projects.

Do you have questions about immigration benefits and the path to citizenship? DOJ accredited professionals from Alianza Hispanoamericana will offer free, personal consultations, as well as assistance with your citizenship application, at the Dundee Library. Alianza Hispanoamericana is a non-profit organization that specializes in immigration help, including citizenship applications and Deferred Action Childhood Arrival (DACA) renewal applications.

Registration is required for citizenship application assistance, but with registration you may attend anytime between 2-5 p.m. Drop-in attendance without registration is welcome for questions on other topics.

To be able to fill out your citizenship application you will need to bring the following documents:

- Your Permanent Resident Card and Social Security Card and your driver's license or state ID
- Dates of all travel outside the U.S. since you received your green card
- A list of all your home addresses for the past 5 years
- A list of all your employer addresses, dates, and locations for the past 5 years
- If currently married, your spouse's name and date of birth and immigration number and date of naturalization
- Date of all marriages and divorces of you and your spouse
- If you have children, their names and their addresses and their dates of birth and their green card numbers (if applicable)
- If you have ever been arrested, reason for arrest and date and place it happened and outcome/disposition
- Males: your Selective Service number and registration date

Prior to the event, you will be contacted by Alianza Hispanoamericana to confirm that you have the necessary documents and information. These services are made possible by a grant awarded by Illinois Access to Justice (A2J). ¿Tiene preguntas sobre los beneficios de inmigración y el camino a la ciudadanía? - Fecha de todos los matrimonios y divorcios de usted y de su pareja
- Si tiene hijos, los nombres, direcciones, fechas de nacimiento y números de tarjeta de residencia (si corresponde) de cada uno.
- Si alguna vez ha sido arrestado, el motivo del arresto, fecha y lugar en que sucedió y el resultado.
- Si es hombre: su número de Servicio Selectivo (Selective Service) y fecha de registro
